I. SPECIFICATIONS:

All material, labor and equipment shall be in accordance with the State of Alabama Department of Transportation Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, latest edition, including any applicable special provisions.

II. REQUIREMENTS:

A. The successful bidder shall provide all materials, equipment and labor necessary to pave various roads in Lauderdale County. The pavement rate for this project shall normally be 150#/sq. yd. for wearing layer and 200 #/sq. yd. for binder. The County Engineer may vary these rates at his discretion.

B. Before any asphalt is placed on any project, the contractor is required to do a ride-through on all roads that are known at the time to be paved with the County Engineer.

C. The Contractor shall be required to clip the shoulders and sweep roads prior to paving. The Contractor shall also be required to grade clipped material back to the shoulders to the satisfaction of the County Engineer, after resurfacing. The contractor will not be required to haul in additional shoulder material. All clipping, sweeping and shoulder grading shall be performed at no additional cost.

D. This project will consist of the following pay items:

- Item 1. 408A-052 Planing Existing Pavement (Approximately 1.10" Thru 2.0" Thick)
Disposal of planing material will be provided by Lauderdale County owned and operated trucks.
- Item 2. 424A, Superpave Bituminous Concrete Wearing Surface Layer, 1/2" Maximum Aggregate Size Mix, ESAL Range A/B – (With Siliceous Aggregate Requirement waived – local approved limestone may be used) (25% RAP Maximum).
- Item 3. 424B, Superpave Bituminous Concrete Upper Binder Layer, 3/4" Maximum Aggregate Size Mix, ESAL Range A/B – (With Siliceous Aggregate Requirement waived – local approved limestone may be used) (25% RAP Maximum).

Item 4. 424A, Superpave Bituminous Concrete Wearing Surface Layer, ½" Maximum Aggregate Size Mix, ESAL Range A/B – (With Siliceous Aggregate Requirement waived – local approved limestone may be used) (25% RAP Maximum). All pickup and delivery of hot mix asphalt will be provided by Lauderdale County owned and operated dump trucks.

Item 5. 424B, Superpave Bituminous Concrete Upper Binder Layer, ¾" Maximum Aggregate Size Mix, ESAL Range A/B – (With Siliceous Aggregate Requirement waived – local approved limestone may be used) (25% RAP Maximum). All pickup and delivery of hot mix asphalt will be provided by Lauderdale County owned and operated dump trucks.

Item 6. 701C-000 Broken Temporary Traffic Stripe

Item 7. 701C-001 Solid Temporary Traffic Stripe

E. It may occasionally be necessary for the contractor to work on small sections of roads near where they are working. This type work will be minimal (10% or less of tonnage). It is the intention of Lauderdale County to work with the contractor in keeping deadheading to a minimum. In most cases the contractor will be able to schedule the sequence of work sites.

F. All bidders shall be Alabama State approved contractors.

G. All material shall conform to State specifications. An approved design mix shall be supplied by the contractor to the County Engineer prior to beginning work.

H. Tack coat shall be used under all paving by the contractor as directed by the County Engineer. This item will be considered a subsidiary obligation of other items of work. No separate payment will be made for tack.

I. Bids will be evaluated, and bonding requirement will be set based on these estimated quantities:

1,000 Square Yards – Planing Existing Pavement (Approximately 1.10" Thru 2.0" Thick)

40,000 Tons - 424A, Superpave Bituminous Concrete Wearing Surface Layer, ½" Maximum Aggregate Size Mix, ESAL Range A/B – (With Siliceous Aggregate Requirement waived – local approved limestone may be used) (25% RAP Maximum).

1,000 Tons - 424B, Superpave Bituminous Concrete Upper Binder Layer, ¾" Maximum Aggregate Size Mix, ESAL Range A/B – (With Siliceous Aggregate Requirement waived – local approved limestone may be used) (25% RAP Maximum).

These quantities are estimate only for bid evaluation purposes. Actual quantities and percentage may vary. The County reserves the right to significantly increase or decrease these estimated quantities.

J. Traffic control for this project shall be provided by the contractor in conformance with the MUTCD. This shall be considered a subsidiary obligation of other items of work. No separate payment will be made.

K. The contractor shall be responsible for proper compaction and testing of the asphalt. QC/QA pay factors will not apply to this project.

L. Asphalt Index Provision will be in effect for this project.

M. All reasonable methods to prevent damage to county roads along the haul will be considered and utilized. These will include, but not be limited to, driver consideration and routing. Should excessive damage continue after all other methods have failed, the County Engineer may require reduced loads.

N. Payment will be made monthly with retainage held in accordance with Alabama Public Works Law.

O. Milling/Planing may be required at critical joints at the discretion of the County Engineer.

P. A temporary broken/solid centerline traffic stripe (701C-000 and 701C-001) shall be put down on paved high-volume roads within 24 hours of road being paved.

Q. All paving and temporary striping projects shall be completed by a date coordinated by the County Engineer to be on or before September 30, 2026.

III. BID REQUIREMENTS:

A. Each bidder shall enclose a certified check or bid bond in the amount of \$10,000.00.

B. The successful bidder shall be required to provide a performance bond in the amount of 100% of the contract price before commencing work.

C. The successful bidder shall provide all other bonding and insurance requirements in accordance with Alabama Public Works Law.

LAUDERDALE COUNTY COMMISSION – INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS (PUBLIC WORKS)

- All bidders are to submit bids on bid forms furnished by the Lauderdale County Commission, which are enclosed with bid invitation. All bid forms are to be signed in all designated areas by an authorized officer of the firm submitting the bid.
- All bidders shall base their proposals on the exact schedule of equipment, materials or services specified herein. Alternates will not be considered unless they conform to specifications. An itemized list containing a breakdown of material and labor costs must accompany bid documents.
- Reference to manufactures, suppliers, catalog numbers, etc., is intended to set quality standards and does not exclude bids from others as long as quality standard and specifications are met. Offers of equal items shall state the brand and number or level of quality.
- Pictures, descriptions and specifications should accompany all bids when required. If samples are required, they shall be furnished free of cost to the Commission.
- All prices submitted on the proposal are to be delivered prices to the Lauderdale County Courthouse or designated site and shall not include any state or local sales tax, except those non-exempt taxes for certain materials as required under state law.
- All bidders must certify that they are an Equal Opportunity Employer and meet E-Verify Requirements with documentation as well as provide proof of Worker's Compensation as required by law.
- Successful bidder must be licensed and have adequate liability insurance coverage filed with the Lauderdale County Commission and abide by all the state laws and local building codes and regulations.
- Should amount of bid exceed \$100,000, a bid bond in the amount of 5% of amount bid must accompany bid. A certified check will be accepted. If a check is submitted and you are not the bid winner, check will be returned with notification letter. If a check is submitted and you are the bid winner, check will be returned upon completion of project or receipt of goods.
- A performance bond in the amount of 100% of contract price may be required at signing of contract.
- All Public Works bids will require withholding of retainage funds equal to 5% of the first half of the total bid and will be disbursed to bidder once four-week completion advertisement affidavit is received by the Lauderdale County Commission and 10 days have lapsed since last advertisement date.
- Any change orders increasing cost or extending delivery/completion date must be approved by the Lauderdale County Commission prior to becoming effective.
- Should a bidder find discrepancies or omissions in bid documents or be in doubt as to their meaning, he should immediately notify the County Administrator, in writing, who will send written instructions to all bidders.
